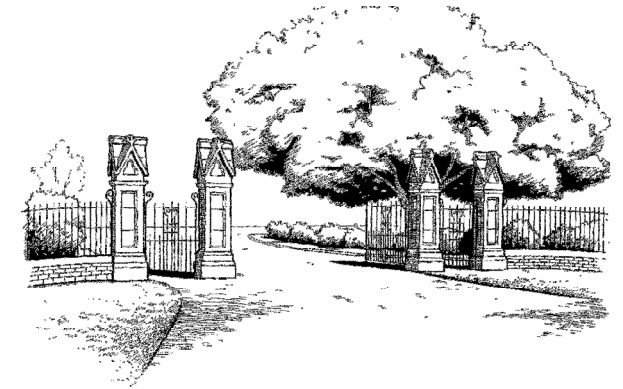
The Toowong Cemetery is the largest cemetery in Queensland and is an important record of the history of Brisbane and Queensland.

The FOTC is a voluntary organisation of people with a special interest in the Toowong Cemetery (formally known as the Brisbane General Cemetery).

We are consulted by the Brisbane City Council in decisions regarding future planning, new initiatives, restoration of graves etc.

The FOTC hold monthly meetings and guided walks in the cemetery on the first Sunday of the month at 10.30am (except January).

Among its activities, the FOTC have published seven guided walking trails throughout the cemetery with others in preparation. Currently available are:

- *Victorian Era Symbolism Trail*
- *The Jewish Trail*
- *The Federation Trail*
- *The Irish Trail*
- *Toowong Identities Courses A & B*
- *In Their Caring Hands* A heritage trail to commemorate the role of nurses, doctors and health professionals

The FOTC have researched and published the *Resource Manual: a guide to visiting Toowong Cemetery*, which is available at Brisbane City Council Libraries, local schools and the Toowong Ward Office. The manual is available for purchase.

*Extraordinary Stories of Ordinary People* is a compilation of stories, submitted by the public, about people buried at Toowong Cemetery. This is the first book in a series published by the FOTC.

The FOTC collates research on individuals buried at Toowong cemetery and Milton/Paddington cemeteries and is building a collection of biographical data.

*The Federation Pavilion*, which was officially opened on the 3rd of March 2001, was an initiative of the FOTC. It commemorates the contribution of the delegates who attended the 1891 Federation buried at Toowong Cemetery.
